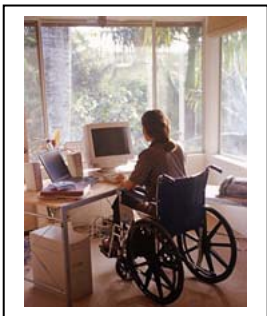
Making the Transition after Disabling Injury
